

USE OF PHOTOGRAPHIC AND RECORDING DEVICES AT COUNTY MEETINGS

In compliance with the Open Meetings Law, Otsego County allows photographing, recording and transmission of County meetings subject to the Open Meetings Law by persons using video, audio, still photography or other similar equipment or devices so long as the equipment or device and the personnel used to operate same are not disruptive or obtrusive.

In order to allow the meetings to be conducted in an orderly manner, anyone wishing to use such equipment or device must sign in with the Clerk of the Board of Representatives for assignment to a specified location.

Walking about the meeting room or moving to a different location is not permitted without the consent of the Chair of the Board of Representatives or the respective committee as applicable. Violations of these guidelines may result in exclusion from the meeting at the discretion of the Chair of the Board or Committee as the case may be.
